d. $(7.8 \times 10^5) + (1.4 \times 10^4)$

e. $(7.24 \times 10^6) + (3 \times 10^6)$

f. $(8.01 \times 10^8) + (4 \times 10^3)$

g. $(4.27 \times 10^5) + (9.3 \times 10^2)$

h. $(2.9 \times 10^{-5}) + (6 \times 10^{-4})$

i. $(2.01 \times 10^{-2}) + (9.3 \times 10^{-4})$

j. $(4.12 \times 10^{-7}) + (8.2 \times 10^{-5})$

2. Solve the following. Give your answers in standard form:

a. $(8 \times 10^6) - (3 \times 10^6)$

b. $(4.81 \times 10^4) - (4.5 \times 10^4)$

c. $(7.51 \times 10^8) - (4.4 \times 10^7)$

d. $(8.32 \times 10^7) - (2.1 \times 10^6)$

e. $(2.7 \times 10^{12}) - (3 \times 10^{10})$

f. $(8.44 \times 10^{-8}) - (3.4 \times 10^{-9})$

g. $(1.6 \times 10^{21}) - (3.3 \times 10^{19})$

h. $(8.132 \times 10^2) - (9.9 \times 10^{-1})$

i. $(8.01 \times 10^{-4}) - (3.3 \times 10^{-3})$

j. $(5.8311 \times 10^8) - (5.42 \times 10^6)$

3. In a science lab there are three petri dishes. The first dish contains 2.75×10^8 bacteria, the second dish contains 6.12×10^5 bacteria and the third dish contains 8.345×10^6 bacteria.

In standard form, how much bacteria is there in the three petri dishes in total?

4. An asteroid was 3.5×10^{11} metres from Earth. It is now 9.391×10^8 metres closer to Earth. How far away is it now?
