5. A van carries 3 people. How many vans do you need to carry 26 people?
6. It costs £9 to get into the theme park. John had £85. How many people can Sam take to the theme park?
7. Bags of sweets cost £6 each. How many bags of sweets can you buy for £40?
8. A minibus carries 11 people. How many minibuses are needed to carry 60 people?
9. It costs £7 per person to eat at the all-you-can-eat restaurant. How many people can eat for £61?
